

English




This term, we will be reading Malorie Blackman's Pig Heart Boy, which tells the poignant story of 13 year old Cameron, who needs a heart transplant. Lessons are based on the understanding of the text and its themes, as well as key narrative, and descriptive writing skills. We also make links with our Science learning.

Maths

This term, we are covering Statistics, Properties of shape and converting units, which will complete the KS2 objectives. Following this, we will be working on a number of consolidation and transition units of work.
