

"A **convention** is an agreement between countries to obey the same law. The United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland agreed to obey (ratified) the Convention on the Rights of the Child on 16 December, 1991. That means our government now has to make sure that every child has all the rights in the convention."



Article 12 (respect for the views of the child)
 Every child has the right to express their views, feelings and wishes in all matters affecting them, and to have their views considered and taken seriously.

Article 15 (freedom of association)
 Every child has the right to meet with other children and to join groups and organisations, as long as this does not stop other people from enjoying their rights.
