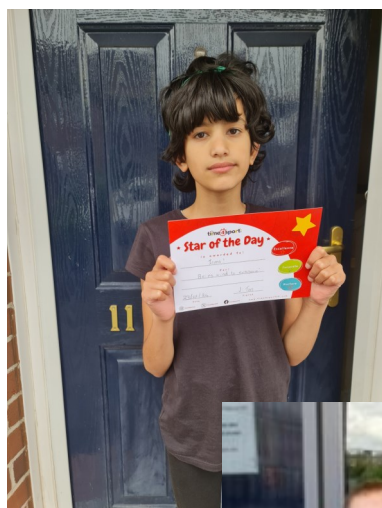
We have lots of new things happening for sport inside school and some exciting things to share with you soon!

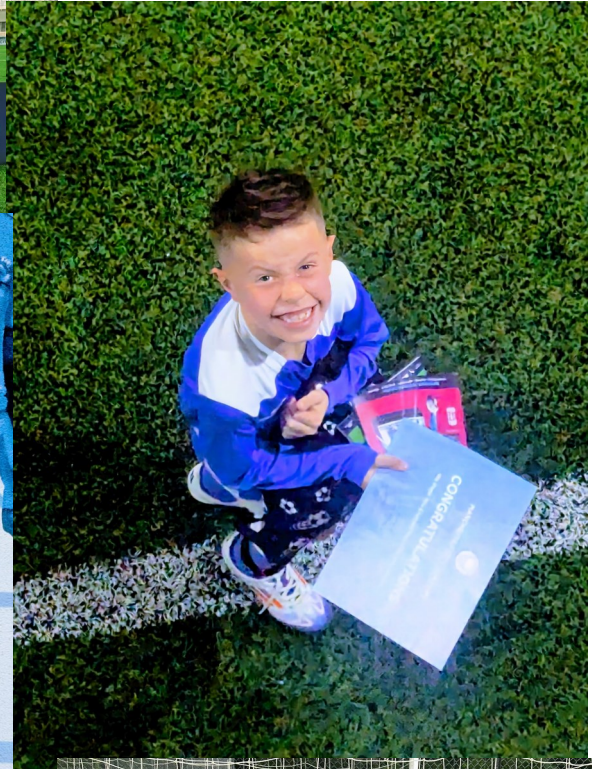
