Things will slow down a bit over the darker, colder months but we will still have lots to share!

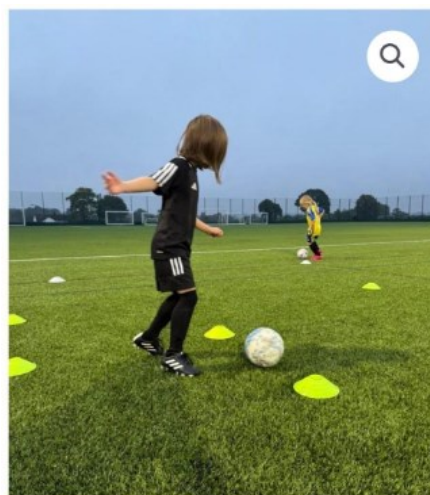
